

NEW HOPE MOPS Kids Bathroom/Diaper Policy

NOTE: MOPS Kids Workers in Light Blue shirts have current background checks with New Hope Church and have been through an application process.

Our MOPS Kids workers CAN:

1. Take child to the bathroom (Preschool bathroom door is to remain open)
2. Hand child toilet paper
3. Lift child on and off of the toilet
4. Help child wash their hands at the sink
5. Give verbal instructions to teach the child how to pull up/down pants and if necessary help the child pull them up/down with **workers hands over the child's hands on the side of the child** (not front or back)
6. Change a diaper if **expressly given permission** by the child's parent on the MOPS Kids Registration Form

Our MOPS Kids workers CANNOT:

1. Help with buttons, belts, zippers, etc. or place hands in the front or back of child
2. Wipe child
3. Close the bathroom door
4. Change a diaper **unless** expressly given permission by the child's parent on the MOPS Kids Registration Form

POTTY TRAINING: If your child **cannot indicate** when he/she has to use the bathroom AND/OR **cannot wipe** on their own, **you must send them in a diaper or pull-up.**

- If your child needs his/her diaper or pull-up changed and the MOPS Kids Workers **have not** been given express permission to do so on the MOPS Kids Registration Form, moms will be contacted. Please leave children with clean diapers.
- Please leave a change of underwear, pants, & socks for children who are being Potty Trained

NURSERY: Workers can change diapers, **if given permission** by their parent on the MOPS Kids Registration Form (Note: Moms may still occasionally be called to change their child's diaper when necessary, even if permission has been given for the MOPS Kids Workers to do so).

Please leave children with clean diapers.
